

EIM CARE COORDINATOR Home Based Care (HBC)

SeniorsPlus has an opening in their EIM Care Coordination program for a full-time, 40 hours/week, salaried position available in the Aroostook or Penobscot county area. Working from a remote office location, the responsible Care Coordinator will provide support primarily through telephonic care coordination, assisting clients participating in Long Term Services and Supports to achieve maximum independence and positively impact and improve their well-being and health care outcomes through a collaborative process of assessment, planning, implementing, monitoring and coordinating with other health care professionals. Coordinates the client's plan of care to ensure continuity of care and coordination of services without duplication of service. Works with providers to gather information about Medicare or services supported by third party insurers; identifying and documenting services, duration of service and provider. Ensures evaluation of the effectiveness of the plan of care, makes recommendations for care plan modifications and identifies barriers to the delivery of service and quality of life. Includes completing assessments, goal development, action plans, and back-up plans.

Adheres to EIM contract requirements and current state program regulations in accomplishment of daily work. Aware of and follows his/her applicable practice and ethical standards. Upholds the values of consumer respect, choice, access, dignity, quality, prevention and early detection. Some travel and home visits are required.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE

Licensed Social Worker or a Registered Nurse or other licensed health professional, within the State of Maine, with a minimum of two years of community experience. A working knowledge of the long term care system, Mainecare and Medicare, as well as Home Care Options required. Case management experience preferred. Strong computer skills required.
